Job Duties:

- In conjunction with Post-Secondary Coordinator identify Post-Secondary Resources and create partnerships that expand opportunities for students
- The Post Secondary Advocate will be responsible for a caseload consisting of the 12th grade students.
- Caseload management will include attendance, academic and social emotional and post secondary support.

- Meet with students on caseload weekly to assess progress, provide resources and support and problem solve any issues that arise.
- Assist students with registration process for Concurrent Enrollment Courses
- In conjunction with the Post-Secondary Coordinator conduct Post-Secondary Readiness bootcamps to prepare students for Post-Secondary opportunities
- Ensure that students understand graduation expectations and deadlines.
- Engage parents/guardians through phone calls, meetings, home visits to inform them of the Post-Secondary Options students are eligible for and explain expectations for programs.
- Participate in New Student Orientation to introduce CHSC Post-Secondary Pathways and opportunities.
- Address barriers to student achievement by connecting students to school based, local community and campus resources.
- Responsible for facilitation of Senior Seminar, in conjunction with the Academic Counselor and Post-Secondary Coordinator.
- Serve as a Liaison between CHSC and Community Based Post-Secondary Resources.
- Assist with enrollment and recruitment of students for Postsecondary opportunities (Concurrent Enrollment, CEC, Workforce Development Programs, Internships, etc.)
- Support students in identifying and developing their Post-Secondary goals and plans.
- Conduct outreach to CHSC graduates to develop an alumni network and inform best practices for current students.
- Coordinate a Career Fair for students each semester.
- Other duties as assigned by Post-Secondary Coordinator and School Administration
